



THE SFA CASHMERE STANDARD

Increasing supply of SFA Certified fibre

- Expanding our reach across Mongolia and into China
- Product claims to drive demand
- Chain of custody an integral part of this expansion
- Our codes of practice cover the certification of raw fibre
- The <u>chain of custody</u> traces this fibre through the supply chain

Goal of the chain of custody

• To ensure the accuracy of claims regarding the **content of SFA Certified fibre** in a final product.



By complying with our chain of custody, you can demonstrate your use of responsibly produced cashmere and may use the SFA Certified Logo






Full segregation with minimum threshold of 33%

BATCH-LEVEL MASS BALANCE WITH DECLARED PERCENTAGE CLAIM








Our 2020 Chain of Custody Pilot


- In 2019, we traced SFA certified fibre up to first-stage processors
- This year, we will trace our fibre all the way to the final garment along four 'goat to coat' pathways
- Reflect common supply chain routes that are relevant for our both our Mongolian, Chinese and international membership base
- Participation only available to SFA Members








- Identify any logistic challenges associated with implementing this particular model in the field


- Have a limited amount of certified fibre available
- We've had commitments to purchase for the chain of custody pathways
- Contact us now if you're interested in sourcing from our certified herders



- The system that records and follows the trail of fibre through the supply chain
- Aim is to compliment members existing traceability systems
- We will use Transaction Receipts, Bag Tags and verified Transaction Certificates for the 2020 CoC Pilot













Bag Tags

- Each batch of product sold in the supply chain (raw fibre, dehaired fibre, fabric or garments) will consist of a number of bags
- For collection from the field, bags that hold up to 100kg of fibre will be provided by the processors and stamped with the SFA Certified logo
- Each bag will have a securely attached tag with its bag ID number (1,2,3, ...X) and batch reference (transaction receipt number) to link it to the sale
- The bag tag will show the seller ID, fibre type, colour, weight and date of sale, along with the ID of the herder organisations that have contributed fibre to that particular batch

Transaction Receipts

- A receipt from a triplicate book will be completed for every transaction of SFA Certified fibre, signed by buyer and seller
- Unique receipt number for each transaction
- Receipt will include the unique ID of the seller and buyer, a product description, the number of bags of each fibre colour and their bag ID numbers, along with their combined weight and price
- For transactions occurring after purchase from herder organisations, each receipt will list the previous (batch references of the fibre included in the sale
- Seller to send the top master receipt (white) to the SFA Mongolia office

Transaction Certificates

- After receiving the Transaction Receipt, the SFA will check the details and verify the sale by issuing a Transaction Certificate to the buyer and seller
- The Certificate will contain the same details as the Transaction Receipt
- Volume reconciliation will be used to check that the amount of certified fibre sold matches the amount that was bought
- Accounting for average conversion rates for the different processing and manufacturing stages along the supply chain








A Transaction Certificate is required every time the product changes ownership






A company does not need to know certification details beyond its immediate supplier to be assured that material purchased is certified.





- Volume reconciliation is done at each point, based on the information in the Transaction Certificates
- Provide us with accurate, verified records of certified inputs and outputs of SFA cashmere
- Means that a single company within the supply chain can make a valid claim to sell SFA Certified cashmere if they have proof of SFA Certified inputs.





What would success look like?

- 1. Batch-level mass balance found to be an appropriate model for SFA cashmere
- 2. Logistic challenges are identified
- 3. SFA Members able to make credible claims
- 4. Information gained to expand the scope of our chain of custody from 2021
- 5. Able to share our experience and lessons learned with the cashmere sector to increase transparency and drive greater volumes of certified fibre through the supply chain.
