

## SFA CLEAN FIBRE PROCESSING CODE OF PRACTICE (CFP CoP): NEW STRUCTURE DRAFT 1

**Introduction:** SFA carried out a mapping exercise to identify indicator duplication across the 12 units within the SFA Clean Fibre Processing CoP. This has informed a potential restructure, adopting a core and options approach, designed to simplify the CoP structure, stream line unit content and eliminate duplication as detailed below.
